# **EQUINE SAFETY INITIATIVES**

KEENELAND'S NUMBER ONE PRIORITY IS THE SAFETY OF ITS HUMAN AND EQUINE ATHLETES. Please see below for important equine safety initiatives that have been implemented for the 2025 Keeneland Association, Inc. ("Keeneland") Fall Race Meet.

- 2025 Keeneland Safety Agreement: This Agreement must be signed by the trainer and attending veterinarian and submitted to the Stable Office or Racing Office upon arrival. This Agreement will cover all Keeneland properties and will be in effect until the end of 2025. A valid and signed 2025 agreement must be on file PRIOR to the acceptance of any entry. The current agreement can be found online at: <u>www.keeneland.com/safetyagreement</u>.
- Medication Restricted Races: Pursuant to HISA Rules, all two-year-old races and stakes races will be conducted Lasixfree. Additional medication restrictions may apply to other races pursuant to the Regulations. Please consult with your veterinarian, Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety Dr. Stuart Brown, the KHRGC, and/or the Authority if you have any questions regarding these rules. 15 U.S.C. § 3055; HISA Rules 4211; 4212.
- 3. Pre-Entry Exam: All horses must have an exam performed by your veterinarian within the three (3) days after the close of entries and no later than two (2) days before the race. This exam is to be documented by your veterinarian and he/ she will include their findings on their daily treatment records submitted to the KHRGC and/or the Authority, as the case may be.
- 4. Pre-Work Exam: All horses must have an exam performed by your veterinarian within the five (5) days preceding a timed workout, per the 2025 Keeneland Safety Agreement. This exam is to be documented by your veterinarian and he/she will include his/her findings on their daily treatment records submitted to the KHRGC or the Authority, as the case may be, and reported to the Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety.
- 5. In-Today Signage: All horses entered to race must be clearly identified starting at 7:30am on race day with an "In-Today" sign. Trainers should hang these signs on the stall door or adjacent to the stall. This is separate from the KHRGC Lasix tag hung following Lasix administration (if permitted). Extra signs are available in the Stable Office.
- 6. Entry Restrictions:
  - A. Age Restrictions. Pursuant to the Regulations, trainers of all first-time starters four (4) years of age or older and previously raced horses that have not raced in the previous 365 days are required to (i) contact a KHRGC Veterinarian to schedule an official work(s) and (ii) ensure that all such horses are approved by such KHRGC Veterinarian PRIOR to entry. Please consult the KHRGC Rules for further information. In addition, any unstarted horse six (6) years old or older shall not be permitted to stable, race, work or train at any Keeneland or TTC Facility unless approved in advance by the Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety or his/her authorized designee.

#### B. Layoffs.

Trainer will not enter in any race a horse that is a four-year old or older first time starter or a previously raced horse that has not raced in the 365 days preceding the date of the selected race UNLESS, in addition to the criteria set forth in Section 3 above and any other criteria set forth in any law, regulation, or house rule, such horse has completed an official work for the KHRGC veterinarian or his/her designee prior to entry. Trainer of any horse that has not raced within one hundred fifty (150) days but has raced within the three hundred sixty-five (365) days preceding the date of the selected race must complete the HISA Layoff Report. Based upon evaluation of the HISA Layoff Report, the KHRGC Veterinarian or the Vice President of Equine Safety or his or her designee may (in his/her sole discretion) impose and require the horse to meet additional requirements prior to being able to enter. If the horse is required to work under this provision, it must meet the same requirements as a horse that is working off of the KHRGC's Veterinarian's List.

C. Poor Performance. A horse that is beaten by twelve (12) or more lengths in each of its last five (5) consecutive starts will be ineligible to stable, race, work or train at any Keeneland or TTC Facility, unless approved in advance by the Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety or his/her authorized designee.

- **D. Restricted Number of Starts.** Horses will be limited to no more than four (4) starts in a rolling eight- (8) week period.
- 7. Waiver Claiming Rule: Trainer may enter a horse into a claiming race but opt to declare the horse ineligible to be claimed if: (a) the horse has not started in 120 days, (b) the horse's last start was for a claiming price, and (c) the subject horse is entered for a claiming price equal to or greater than the claiming price for which the horse last started. Trainer may also opt to declare a Covered Horse ineligible to be claimed for a second consecutive race provided: (a) the waiver must have been asserted in the first race back to be eligible for the second waiver; (b) if the subject horse wins the first race back, it is ineligible for the second waiver; (c) if the subject horse changes majority ownership subsequent to the first race, it is ineligible for the second waiver; and (d) the provisions of HISA Rule 2263(a) still apply.
- 8. Shock Wave Treatments: All prescribed shockwave treatments require 48-hour notice regardless of location of treatment. Please contact the KHRGC Equine Medical Director for permission to treat. Following a shockwave treatment (including, without limitation, extracorporeal shock wave therapy), a horse shall not (i) race for a minimum of thirty (30) days following treatment or (ii) participate in a high-speed work for fourteen (14) days following treatment. In addition, all shockwave machines must be registered with HISA. HISA Rule 2272. Trainers and veterinarians violating this rule are subject to HISA penalties along with revocation of stalling privileges at any Keeneland or TTC Facility.
- Speed Work Preference Window During Morning Training: Preference will be provided to horses performing officially timed speed works during the first 10 minutes following any renovation breaks.
- 10. Working After Placement on Veterinarian's List: Trainer will not permit a horse placed on the Veterinarian's List to perform a high-speed (published) work for seven (7) days following placement on the Veterinarian's List.

Except in the case of "House Rules", if there is any discrepancy between the information set forth below and any applicable Regulation, the rules of the KHRGC or the Authority, as the case may be, shall govern. Otherwise, Keeneland's decisions govern and are final.

Trainer and attending veterinarian will abide to abide by all Regulations and Keeneland rules, including without limitation any House Rules and other rules (including, without limitation all rules set forth in this Keeneland Condition Book, Stall Application, Safety Agreement, the Rules of the Barn Area, and the Rules of the Track), all of which are hereby expressly incorporated by reference herein, as the same may be updated, modified or amended. Trainer and attending veterinarian shall be responsible for obtaining and becoming familiar with such rules and regulations. Ignorance of the applicable rules and regulations shall not be an excuse for non-compliance.

All Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund ("KTDF") purse allotments contained herein are subject to KHRGC approval.

#### HISA REGISTRATION

All racing participants, or "Covered Persons," must register with the Authority pursuant to the Regulations. Trainers must also register all horses in their care. This can be done after the Trainer registers with HISA pursuant to the Regulations.

You are considered a Covered Person if you are licensed by any state racing commission OR:

- You have involvement with Thoroughbred Covered Horses or Thoroughbred Covered Horseraces; OR
- You have access to restricted areas of a racetrack in the ordinary course of your work.
   Go to www.hisaus.org to register. See HISA Rule 9000.

If you have no contact with Covered Horses and you do not have access to the restricted areas of a racetrack, such as the stable area, in the ordinary course of carrying out your duties you do not have to register. Examples of persons who do not need to register include, but are not limited to: vendors of goods or services and racetrack employees or contractors who do not have access to restricted areas (i.e. food service providers, mutuel employees, etc.).

ALL racehorses MUST be registered with HISA within 24 hours of arrival at Keeneland regardless of their Covered status. This allows your veterinarian to comply with HISA regulations requiring them to submit electronic medical records. This includes 2-year-old when they come to the track prior to their first official work.

# HORSES THAT ARE NOT PROPERLY REGISTERED WITH THE AUTHORITY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RACE, TRAIN, OR WORK AT KEENELAND.

# The Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund (KTDF)



Horsemen with Kentucky-sired Kentucky-breds have over \$55 million more in purse money to run for in designated stakes, handicap, allowance, nonclaiming maiden races, and claiming races contested at licensed Thoroughbred race meetings in Kentucky.

Eligible races can be readily recognized in the stakes and condition books by the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund seal, which will appear next to each race in the stakes and condition books.

In accordance with KRS 230.400(5)(d), it is mandatory for a horse to be registered prior to time of entry to be eligible to participate in the distribution of Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund monies. Registration is only complete once the application is approved and payment has been received.

All horses of racing age that are both Kentucky-bred and sired by a Kentucky stallion which stood in Kentucky the entire breeding season the year the horse was conceived are eligible to be registered. Owners of horses of racing age are responsible for registering their horses. Stallion owners are responsible for registering their stallions.

Registration applications may be obtained from the official registrar, the Kentucky Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders, by contacting:

Registration may be completed online at <a href="https://www.kta-ktob.com">www.kta-ktob.com</a>. The Horse Identifier can check registration status of a horse.

For those horses that are registered and eligible according to the conditions listed above, fund monies will be divided as follows. After payment of 1.25% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last place, the remaining fund monies will be divided:

62% to the owner of the winning horse 20% to the owner of the 2nd place finisher 10% to the owner of the 3rd place finisher 5% to the owner of the 4th place finisher 3% to the owner of the 5th place finisher See chart on Page 9.

Unearned fund monies revert to the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund. Additionally, if a non-KTDF eligible horse is involved in a dead heat, those funds will revert to the fund. See Example for distribution on Page 9.

### **ENTRIES. SCRATCHES & ALSO-ELIGIBLES**

- Scratches will be considered by stewards upon submission.
- All scratches must be submitted by 8:00am EST on the day of the race.
- lockeys must be named at the time of entry.
- Entry closing dates are listed at the top of each page of conditions.

# A valid and signed 2025 Keeneland Safety Agreement must be signed by both trainer and attending veterinarian and on file PRIOR to the acceptance of any entry.

# **Digital Foal Certificates:**

The Jockey Club registry issues digital foal certificates for foals of 2018 and later. Digital certificates are stored on the Registry's website at registry.jockeyclub.com. If you are planning on running at Keeneland ask your owners to assign digital certificates of horses eight-years-old or less who have digital certificates to Keeneland as the "Certificate Manager". All digital foal papers will be treated the same as paper foal papers and must be on file by Sunday, September 28 for a zero date. For horses born in 2017 and older, continue to deliver paper certificates to Keeneland Racing Office, Attention: Horse I.D.

If you have questions about digital foal certificates, see the digital certificates FAQs at registry.jockeyclub.com or contact the Registry office via email at inquiries@jockeyclub.com or by phone at (800) 444-8521.

#### KEENELAND DATE PREFERENCE SYSTEM

The Date System of preference will be used at Keeneland as described below:

Paper foal certificates and digital foal certificates (collectively, "Foal Certificates") are no longer required to be retained on file in the racing office to enter or start at Keeneland; however, Foal Certificates must be on file to obtain a preference date and to get a horse digitally tattooed.

To receive a zero (0) date, Foal Certificates must be on file with the Horse Identifier by Sunday, September 28.

# Preference by Keeneland condition eligibility then by:

- In over-filled races, preference will be given to horses in order of their assigned preference dates, earliest date first. Horses having identical dates will be chosen by lot; however, where entry and running dates are the same, the horse with the entry date will have preference.
- All horses intended for racing at Keeneland will be assigned a preference date. Dates assigned will be of two types:

#### E-Date

This date will correspond to:

- a. The day on which a horse's Foal Certificate and name tag are submitted to the Horse Identifier (the earliest date being the day when entries are first taken for the meeting). An unnamed horse will not receive and E-Date.
- b. The day on which a horse is first entered if his papers are not on file with the Horse Identifier.

c. To qualify for the latter E-Date, a horse must have been excluded from a race which appears on the overnight or he must have been entered in a condition book race which failed to fill through insufficient entries.

#### R-Date

This date will correspond to:

- a. The day of a horse's most recent race at Keeneland.
- b. An R-Date will also be assigned to a horse which scratches (provided the Foal Certificates are on file with the identifier).
- 3. A horse retains his R-Date until he receives a newer R-Date. No horse with an established R-Date may receive an E-Date. A horse whose Foal Certificates are removed from the Horse Identifier's office will lose his date and must subsequently re-establish a date in order to receive preference. A horse with an E-Date cannot receive a newer E-Date. Horses starting at another racetrack will forfeit any date they may have at Keeneland. Additionally, horses racing at Keeneland without Foal Certificates on site will not retain their R-Date.
- 4. Preference dates will consist of two categories: Dirt (D) and Turf (T). Preference dates are good for any type of race or distance.
- A horse that runs in a race, which has been taken off the Turf will retain its Turf date and establish a Dirt R-Date. A scratched horse will receive an R-Date from the date scratched for both Turf and Dirt.
- 6. Horses on the Also-Eligible list shall be permitted to draw into races in order listed.
- 7. No E-Date will be assigned to the second choice of an unsplit same-owner entry.
- A horse which has been placed on a list (veterinarian, Steward, starter or paddock judge) will lose their date and be assigned an R-Date corresponding to the day removed from list, provided the Foal Certificates are on file with the Horse Identifier.
- 9. A horse which is a scheduled starter in a canceled race will not receive an R-Date for that race but will retain its previous date.
- 10. Stakes and handicap races are not subject to date preference.
- Preference dates are transferred through change of ownership and changes in trainer
  after the proper transfer procedure have been completed through the Steward's
  office and delivered to the Racing Secretary's Office.
- Date preference rules will not supersede KHRGC rules regarding preference, eligibility or scratches.
- 13. Winners will be preferred in all non-maiden races.

# **Condition Preference**

- Horses are preferred by their available conditions in all allowance races beginning
  with Graded stake winners (Grade I-II-III), open stakes winners through their
  allowance conditions (when allowance conditions are equal, an open stakes winners
  shall be preferred) providing the horse has finished 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th for \$50,000
  or more since starting for less than \$50,000. In allowance/optional claiming races a
  horse's preference cannot exceed the condition of the race. Starter races for less than
  \$40,000 will not be preferred.
- No entry will be received except upon the condition that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of the conditions of any race shall be decided by the officers of the association, or those whom they may appoint and their decision upon all points shall be final.
- No entry shall be accepted from any stable not provided with a trainer's license.
- Keeneland will no longer accept Main Track Only (MTO) entries.

# Weight

Owners and trainers must be careful to claim allowances at the time of entry, and state penalties, and are solely responsible if a horse starts with the incorrect weight and is therefore disqualified.

# **Special Notices**

- Keeneland reserves the right to start any or all races with or without a stall gate starting machine.
- Horses claimed, transferred or sold to any person or stable, not registered for racing at Keeneland, must be removed from the grounds within twenty-four (24) hours, unless approved by the Stewards and Keeneland.
- Trainers accept the responsibility for all persons for whom they are acting with regard
  to the Regulations and conditions of Keeneland, and agrees to be bound by and
  comply with the same, as well as all acts and decisions of Keeneland, the KHRGC, the
  Authority, HIWU, and the Racing Officials.
- Every horse must be saddled in the paddock. This rule is imperative. Horses must be in the paddock at least twenty minutes before the bugle call. Ponies may not accompany horses in the walking ring.
- Upon going to the post, all horses must parade in front of the stand in the order assigned to them on the official program.
- All two-year-olds must be properly schooled and approved by the starter before being allowed to start.
- At the discretion of the Stewards, and without notice, the entries of any person, or acceptance or transfer of any entries, may be refused.
- The Stewards reserve the right to substitute one jockey for another, at their discretion. It will be their purpose to substitute a jockey of equal ability.
- Neat dress required. All trainers and accompanying stable personnel should be neatly dressed when taking horses to the paddock. Pony personnel taking horses to the post in the public parade must wear jackets available at the paddock gate and must keep themselves and their mounts well-groomed and their tack clean.
- There will be an outrider on the track every day for your protection and if at any time he/she can be of assistance, please do not hesitate to ask.
- All participants (as defined herein) shall adhere to Keeneland's policies and procedures regarding appropriate conduct and behavior, including, but not limited to information listed under **Appropriate Conduct** on page 17 of this condition book.

#### Field Size

Field size shall be determined by Keeneland, in its sole and absolute discretion.

# **Turf Course Special Notices**

- All races programmed to be run on the turf course may, in the event of a change
  in the condition of the course, to preserve the condition of the turf course in the
  interests of safety or integrity, or for any other reason in Keeneland's sole and
  absolute discretion, be transferred and run over the main track.
- All races transferred from the turf course to the main track will be run at the same distance with two exceptions: races at one mile and one-half on the turf will be contested at one mile and five-eighths on the main track and races for 2 year olds at five and one-half furlongs will be contested at four and one-half furlongs on main track.
- Ponies will not be allowed on the turf course.

#### **Veterinarian Examinations**

At all times, a horse must be in serviceable, sound racing condition in order to stable, train, work or race at any Keeneland facility. Trainer will not enter a horse in any race UNLESS the horse has: (a) been examined by horse's attending veterinarian during the three (3) days immediately preceding the close of entries to race and no later than two (2) days before the race for the express purpose of evaluating the horse's fitness to race; (b) been found fit to race by the attending veterinarian, and (c) met all other applicable regulatory requirements to be entered in a race. This evaluation shall include, at a minimum, examination of the legs and observation of the horse at rest and while jogging. The attending veterinarian and trainer are obligated to inform the Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety and the KHRGC Veterinarian of any changes in the horse's fitness after entry through race day. The Trainer acknowledges it is his/her obligation to (a) confirm the horse is in serviceable, sound racing condition in order to stable, train, work or race at any Keeneland Facility and (b) inform the Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety of any changes in the horse's fitness or health that would prevent a horse from stabling, training, working or racing at any Keeneland facility or any changes that would put Trainer or the attending veterinarian or any horse in violation of these conditions. **Keeneland may refuse to accept any** entry UNLESS and UNTIL a fully executed copy of Keeneland's Safety Agreement, signed by the trainer and the trainer's attending veterinarian, has been submitted to Keeneland's Racing Office.

The KHRGC appoints an official veterinarian ("KHRGC Veterinarian") who performs his or her duties as set forth in the relevant KHRGC Rules (including, without limitation, 810 KAR 2:010) and, pursuant to an agreement with the Authority, certain other duties under the HISA Rules, maintains the KHRGC and/or HISA practices and procedures, and ensures compliance with those practices and procedures. At any time, the Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety and/or the KHRGC Veterinarian, or their respective designee, may perform such examinations as either party may deem necessary or advisable (including, without limitation, those examinations and certifications required by any Regulations to assess a horse's soundness to train, work or race). Such examinations may include (but are not limited to) pre-and post-training, work and race inspections, and may consist of observing the horse while being jogged and at rest as well as examining the horse's legs, attitude and demeanor, all while referencing past training, work or race-day exam information provided by the KHRGC Veterinarian's records. In addition, such examinations may include diagnostic tests as part of the evaluation of the horse's soundness. Any horse that is deemed unsound may be scratched from a race or **not permitted to train or work.** Keeneland and the KHRGC Veterinarian are entitled (but not obligated) to contact, without prior notice, a horse's attending veterinarian(s) to confirm that examinations have been conducted pursuant to these rules and the applicable Regulations and that any such examination(s) meets Keeneland requirements. Keeneland shall have the right (but not the obligation) to examine and review all records on any horse in accordance with these conditions. Trainer agrees that Keeneland and the Vice President of Equine Safety (or his designee) shall have the right to inspect and copy for each's own use, and Trainer shall provide on request, all documents, electronic or otherwise, containing reports by official racing veterinarians of pre-race examinations. post-race examinations (including without limitation necropsy reports) and/or any records of procedures required by regulatory agencies or under applicable industry safety accreditations of Trainer's horse(s) racing or training at each Keeneland facility. In addition, Trainer shall notify the Vice President of Equine Safety (or his or her designee) prior to resuming training of any horse placed on any regulatory veterinarian's list on Keeneland or TTC grounds.

The Horsemen's Bookkeepers' offices will be open from 8:30 am until after the last race on live racing days.

The Horsemen's Bookkeepers' office, located inside the Racing Secretary's Office, will be open from 8:30 am until after the last race on live racing days.

Prior to participation in a race owners are required to establish an account with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper to include ALL of the following:

- Complete address information
- W-9 or W-8ECI
- Jockey fees
- Fees for stakes engagements

Keeneland may refuse entry to any person(s) who has not paid monies owed to Keeneland, including but not limited to, stall rent, nomination fees, entry fees, starting fees and jockey fees.

Any balance owed to Keeneland may be paid with a credit card (Visa, MC, AMEX, Discover). Credit card authorization forms are available through the Horsemen's Bookkeeper. A transaction fee of 3% will be applied to any balances over \$5,000 paid via credit card.

# **Partnerships**

If a horse runs in the name of a partnership, the check will be issued in the name(s) of those listed on the designated partnership account. The Horsemen's Bookkeeper will not pay out percentages to different partners; it is the responsibility of the partnership to disperse funds accordingly.

# **Tax Reporting**

A tax ID (SSN or FEIN) is required before any funds can be released. An IRS form W9 or W8ECI certifying the tax ID must be submitted to "Keeneland Association, Inc." In the case of partnership accounts, a W9 is required from ONLY ONE of the partners and all income for the account will be reported to the IRS using that partner's tax ID.

# **Complimentary Wire Transfer to Churchill Downs**

As a courtesy to our horsemen upon request, Keeneland will wire funds to Churchill Downs at the conclusion of our meet. A W9 is required for each account that requests this service.

# **Required Forms**

*United States Residents* – Horsemen must have a signed W-9 on file with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper before any purse money will be distributed.

*United States Non-Residents* - The Internal Revenue Service requires that Keeneland withhold and pay 30% of purses paid to a non-resident of the United States, if the person

paid does not possess a valid Federal Taxpayer Identification Number, to the IRS. Each non-resident must complete a FORM W8ECI, and place on file with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper.

TAX FORMS can be picked up in either Horsemen's Bookkeeper's office. Completed forms can be dropped off at either location, faxed to 859-280-4730, or emailed to horsebook@keeneland.com.

Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance (TAA) \$10-per-start 'opt-out' contribution Keeneland has partnered with the TAA, a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization, in an effort to ensure quality aftercare for our equine athletes when their racing careers are over. A \$10 fee will be collected from each owner's account and contributed to the TAA for every horse that starts a race at Keeneland. Furthermore, Keeneland will match all contributions collected in order to double the impact. Participation is optional. If, for any reason, you choose not to support this program, you may opt out by emailing the Horsemen's Bookkeeper at horsebook@keeneland.com.

**Funds for claims:** All funds must be available on account in order to be used for claims.

#### PURSE DISTRIBUTION

After payment of 1.25% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last place, the remaining Association purse will be divided:

62% to the owner of the winning horse 20% to the owner of the 2nd place finisher 10% to the owner of the 3rd place finisher 5% to the owner of the 4th place finisher 3% to the owner of the 5th place finisher

#### TATTOO/MICROCHIP

All owners who have horses digitally tattooed on Keeneland's grounds, shall pay the \$110 fee directly to the TRPB Identifier. If the horse's first career start is at Keeneland, the owner's HB account will be credited in the same amount.

Effective January 1, 2020, Race Horse Identification transitioned from lip tattooing to utilizing the Digital Tattoo (Picture Horse ID) which is accessible through scanning of the Jockey Club issued Microchip implanted in the horse's neck by the breeder.

All foals of 2017 and forward must be microchipped before the Jockey Club will register the horse.

All foals of 2016 and older who are not tattooed and who currently do not have a microchip need to contact The Jockey Club (#800-444-8521) to obtain a microchip. The Jockey Club issued microchip must be inserted into the horse and listed on the Foal Certificate before the horse is Digitally Tattooed prior to its first race.

Like the old tattoo system, TRPB Identifiers will come to the barn, then scan the microchip to pull up the digital copy of the foal papers and verify the markings prior to the horse being allowed to race. Additionally, the TRPB Identifiers will take a series of photographs of the horse.

All participants must comply with current HISA Regulations, available through the QR code below, including but not limited to the following:

#### **HISA Rules PDF Download**

Keeneland encourages all horsemen to familiarize themselves with all HISA Regulations.

Please note the following:

- 1) ALL racehorses MUST be registered with HISA within 24hr of arrival at.

  Keeneland regardless of their Covered status. This allows your veterinarian to comply with HISA regulations requiring them to submit electronic medical records. This includes 2-yr old horses that come to the track prior to their first official work.
- Pre-work exams (where a published work is intended) must have a veterinary exam performed by your attending veterinarian within the 5 days prior to the work.
- Pre-entry exams are still required at the time of entry into a race by your attending veterinarian.

Please also note the veterinary related HISA Regulation changes that took effect on **JULY 8 2024**:

- All shockwave machines must be registered with HISA. Additionally, horses are now allowed to have a high-speed work <u>14 days</u> following treatment, as previously there was a 30 day stand down. <u>There remains a 30-day stand down</u> <u>for racing</u>. All prescribed shockwave treatments require a forty-eight (48) hour notice regardless of location.
- Fetlock intra-articular injections of corticosteroids are prohibited from
  participating in high-speed works for 14 days and racing for 30 days. All other
  intra-articular injections (other than fetlocks with corticosteroids) continue
  to have a 7 day stand down for high-speed works and 14 day stand down for
  racing.
- 3. Following regulatory veterinarian clearance for a horse who has not started in the previous 365 days OR a 4yr old or older first-time starter, the horse has **60 days** in which to start or will be required to work again for the regulatory veterinarian with blood drawn to regain eligibility. Please schedule accordingly.
- A horse placed on the unsound list is prohibited from participating in a highspeed work for 7 days.

 For horses that are scratched from a race as <u>SICK</u>, <u>ILL</u>, or <u>INJURED</u>, the attending veterinarian will need to complete a physical exam and record their findings with HISA. <u>Please plan accordingly to avoid issues when entering horses to</u> <u>race following a SICK, ILLNESS, or INJURED scratch.</u>

# Requirements for Equine Health Documents

All horses, including lead ponies, seeking entrance to Keeneland's stable area(s) shall be accompanied by the following as well as all documentation required by HISA Rule 2143: (1) A current negative Equine Infections Anemia (Coggins) Test dated less than one year prior to date of arrival, or such shorter period of time in the event a high-risk situation dictates, and listed on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), which has been signed and dated within seventy-two (72) hours prior to arrival by a licensed veterinarian or by the approval of the Vice President of Equine Safety.

(2) A vaccination against Equine Herpes Virus Type 1 (EHV-1) by a licensed veterinarian a minimum of fourteen (14) days, and no more than one hundred twenty (120) days of entry into Keeneland's stable area(s). The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall indicate the date of the vaccination, the specific vaccine product, vaccine lot number, and vaccine expiration date, used to vaccinate each horse.

# <u>Duty to Report</u>

In addition to any duty to report under state or federal law, Trainers are under a continuing obligation to report immediately to Keeneland any change in the health of a horse under Trainer's care, including without limitation fevers of unknown origin or any symptom of any potentially contagious or communicable disease.

# **Ban on Horse Cruelty or Slaughter**

Kentucky law makes it a crime to engage in any form of animal cruelty, including the mistreatment, abuse, or neglect of a horse, with specific additional punishments applicable only to equine-related crimes. KRS 525.130. The KHRGC also has the authority to suspend, deny, or revoke any KHRGC license in the event a licensee abandons, mistreats, abuses, neglects, or engages in any act of cruelty to a horse. 810 KAR 3:020, Section 15. In addition, any owner, or trainer or other connection who directly or indirectly participates in the transport, sale, or transfer of a horse previously stabled at Keeneland or any affiliated Keeneland property for slaughter may have his/her stalls permanently revoked and shall permanently forfeit all stabling and racing privileges at Keeneland and any Keeneland-affiliated property. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, Keeneland reserves its common-law right to exclude any person for any reason in its sole and absolute discretion, including, without limitation, the mistreatment, abuse, or neglect of a horse. 810 KAR 3:020.

# **Toll Free Reporting Hotline**

The mistreatment, abuse, neglect and abandonment of animals is not permitted on Keeneland property or elsewhere. An anonymous toll-free reporting hotline is available. Any person who wishes to report an incident may call 844-747-2553 and leave a message. Alternatively, you may contact the Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety at 859 280-4757. Messages will be retrieved daily. Keeneland will investigate all reports.

# **Substance Abuse**

# **Appropriate Conduct**

There is an expectation of appropriate conduct at all times with respect to language and behavior towards others for anyone working or residing on Keeneland or Keeneland-affiliated grounds. Abusive language, threatening, violent, uncouth, or discriminatory behavior and language is strictly forbidden and will not be tolerated. Keeneland reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to eject anyone not observing these standards.

# ANTI-DOPING AND MEDICATION CONTROL ("ADMC") RULES; OTHER PROCEDURES

# **Race-Day Medication**

All Trainers and horses must abide by current anti-doping and medication control Regulations including Regulations regarding furosemide (a/k/a Lasix or Salix). Please refer to khrc.ky.gov and/or hisaus.org/regulations for current race-day medication and anti-doping control rules.

#### HISA ADMC Rules

#### **STABLING**

A stall application is required for every person seeking to be stabled on Keeneland's grounds. Applications may be obtained at <a href="https://www.keeneland.com">www.keeneland.com</a> or by contacting the stable office.

Keeneland reserves the right to refuse stabling space, or to refuse the acceptance of any entry in any race for any reason or cause, and without notice to the trainer.

Trainers agree to abide by all Regulations.

Trainers agree to vacate stalls and move all horses, equipment, and personnel, upon request, from Keeneland property within a reasonable time.

All stable reservations made, and every entry in any race will be accepted only on the condition that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of any Regulations, rules or conditions or races or otherwise shall be decided by the Authority, KHRGC, Stewards of the meet or Keeneland, as the case may be, and such decision(s) upon all points shall be final.

- \*All stalls must be cleaned prior to shipping out of Keeneland's grounds.
- \* No vehicles are permitted to park in the grass or walking rings between barns until after 2:00 p.m. each day. Vehicles found in these areas will be towed at the owner's expense.

# Ship-Ins

Entrant agrees that any horse running at Keeneland will be on Keeneland's grounds a minimum of four and one-half (4 ½) hours prior to race time in default of which Entrant understands that the horse shall be scratched.

# **Stakes Security**

All horses entered in a stakes race will be subject to mandatory security surveillance from four and one half (4 ½) hours to post. All person(s) entering the barn must have a valid KHRGC-issued license and will be documented by surveillance personnel.

#### **OTHER HOUSE RULES**

\*Any trainer not in compliance with any Keeneland house rules may be subject to monetary fines and/or removal of horses from grounds.

# **Bedding**

Unless a request for shavings has been approved by the Racing Secretary, all stalls must be bedded with straw. Sawdust is not permitted.

## Water Hoses\*

All hoses in the barn area must be fitted at all times with a working nozzle, such that water will not flow from a hose unless the nozzle is engaged.

# **Heat Lamps\***

Heat lamps are prohibited at all times in the stall areas.

### Ice Machines\*

Ice machines are prohibited at all times in the stall areas.

# Dogs\*

All dogs must be kept inside tack rooms during training and racing hours, or if out, must be leashed and in hand at all times. Under no circumstances may dogs be tied in shedrows or about the barns during these hours. Dogs tied in shedrows at hours other than the above mentioned must be on a fixed, short leash to permit free access and passage of Keeneland's security police around the barn area. No running chains or lines will be permitted. This action is being taken in order to permit the daily routine business of veterinarians, blacksmiths, feed delivery, track security, deliveries, and barn maintenance personnel.

# **Washing Machines\***

No washing machines may be brought into the stall areas. An equine laundry facility is available between Barn 42 and the Maintenance Building and may be utilized by Trainer/Owner and staff as available.

#### **SURFACES**

#### Main Dirt Track

In the summer of 2014, Keeneland converted its 1 1/16-mile main track from Polytrack to dirt. The dirt racing surface is a blend of approximately 19,000 tons of sand, silt and clay native to Kentucky. The surface composition is approximately 87.5 percent sand and 12.5 percent clay and silt. The new surface debuted during the 2014 Fall Meet.

# **Turf Courses**

The Haggin Course: Keeneland's 7½-furlong turf course is named for former Keeneland President Louis Lee Haggin II. Stretch length: 1,190 feet. Width: 90 feet at the finish line. The temporary rail can be set 10, 20, or 30 feet from inside the rail.

# **Training Track**

Polytrack. Keeneland's 5-furlong training track has an all-weather Polytrack surface, which was renovated during the summer of 2021.

#### WORKOUTS

\*All Trainers must provide Keeneland Clockers with Horse Name, Distance and Trainer PRIOR to workout (by pedigree if horse is unnamed) and the horse must be entered in the current Trainers' Keeneland Stall Inventory as per Keeneland's requirements for access to racing surfaces while stabled on the grounds and the publishing of a timed public work.

#### KHRGC Workout Rule

## ENTRIES, SUBSCRIPTIONS AND DECLARATIONS

810 KAR 4:030. ENTRIES, SUBSCRIPTIONS AND DECLARATIONS Section 3, Subsection 8, (a), (b) and (c) (8) (a) A horse that has not started in the past forty-five (45) days shall not be permitted to start unless it has at least one (1) published workout within twenty (20) days of entry at a distance satisfactory to the stewards. If a horse has performed the requisite workout, but the workout does not appear in the past performances, the horse shall be permitted to start if the stewards determine that the workout failed to be published through no fault of the trainer. (b) A horse that has not started in the past ninety (90) days shall not be permitted to start unless it has at least two (2) published workouts during the past ninety (90) day period, one of which occurs within twenty (20) days of entry at a distance satisfactory to the stewards. If a horse has performed the requisite workouts, but the workouts do not appear in the past performances, the horse shall be permitted to start if the stewards determine that the workout failed to be published through no fault of the trainer. (c) A horse that has not started in the past 180 days shall not be permitted to start unless it has at least three (3) published workouts during the past 180-day period, one (1) of which occurs within twenty (20) days of entry, at a distance satisfactory to the stewards. If a horse has performed the requisite workouts, but the workouts do not appear in the past performances, the horse shall be permitted to start if the stewards determine that the workouts failed to be published through no fault of the trainer. (d) A horse starting for the first time shall not be permitted to start unless it has three (3) workouts, one (1) of which is from the starting gate, one (1) of which is within twenty (20) days of entry, and at least one (1) of which is published. (e) A workout not appearing in the official program shall be publicly displayed on television monitors, the tote board, and, if available, the bulletin boards where photo finishes are shown at the time when mutuel windows are opened and shall be displayed until the conclusion of the race in which the horse is entered. For additional information on this and other regulations, please refer to the KHRGC website at khrc.ky.gov

The turf course will be open for a limited number of workouts immediately after the main track is closed at 10:00 a.m. on Saturdays and Tuesdays.

Turf workouts will be limited to horses who are nominated (nominations closed) to stakes races on the turf at Keeneland.

Turf slips must be picked up at the racing secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the workout.

All horses must work between the "dogs" in a counterclockwise direction.

A horse will not be permitted to work UNLESS the horse has: (a) been examined by the Trainer's attending veterinarian during the five (5) days immediately preceding the work for the express purpose of evaluating the horse's fitness to work; (b) been found fit to work by the attending veterinarian (this evaluation shall include, at a minimum, watching the horse jog).

The attending veterinarian and trainer are obligated to inform the Keeneland Vice President of Equine Safety or the KHRGC Veterinarian of any changes in the horse's fitness after the examination set forth above and before the horse works.

# **KEENELAND MILESTONE TROPHY PROGRAM**

Keeneland offers a Milestone Trophy Program that features several levels of recognition for owners whose horses win graded stakes at the track.

Owners of horses that win graded stakes races receive a Keeneland Trophy Cup. Owners who win eight Trophy Cups are awarded a Keeneland Tray; another eight Trophy Cups earns a Keeneland Pitcher; eight more graded stakes wins earns a Keeneland Bowl, and eight more (32 graded stakes wins total) earns the coveted Keeneland Vase.

If the winning owner is a partnership, the primary partner will receive credit for the Milestone Trophy count. The primary partner will be the owner whose silks the horse carries in the stakes.

#### RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

As the organizer, host, and sponsor of Thoroughbred horse races, Keeneland hereby reserves unto itself, its agents, assigns and licensees, and each participant, including, without limitation, owners, trainers, jockeys, and grooms of horses being entered in Keeneland races or otherwise training or being stabled at Keeneland, and their heirs, representatives, successors, next of kin and assigns (collectively, "Participants"), hereby assigns to Keeneland all interest, right, title, and interest he, she, or it may have in and to the Host Rights, as herein defined. The Host Rights shall mean the sole and exclusive right to: (a) produce, exhibit, sell, license, transfer or transmit in any manner still or motion pictures, radio and television broadcasts, digital and immersive media or any other media transmission, now known or hereafter developed, of all events which occur on Keeneland's property, including without limitation, all activities occurring before, during and after Thoroughbred horse races and training at any Keeneland track; (b) utilize the race and the results thereof, all for any purpose or use as Keeneland shall determine; (c) limit, prohibit or regulate the display of any commercial advertising symbols, or other identification, other than Participant's registered silks, in connection with any race, training, or related activities; and (d) develop, produce and sell, by or through any licensee, goods using the Participant's name or likeness, the name or likeness of any horse owned by the Participant brought onto Keeneland's grounds, or any other identifying feature, silks, trademark or copyrighted material which is used in connection with Keeneland racing or training activities. In consideration of participating in stabling, racing, training and related activities at Keeneland, Participant consents to the above reservation of the Host Rights and consents to be photographed or to otherwise by a subject of still or moving pictures, radio or television programs or other digital and/or immersive media, without remuneration except for contributions to horsemen's purses from wagering on the races as established by contract or legislation. Participant agrees that participant has not and will not execute any documents or take any other action which purports to assign or otherwise transfer any interest in the Host Rights or assert any claim, demand or cause of action against Keeneland which is inconsistent with the full and exclusive exercise by Keeneland of its Host Rights. Participant's entry on Keeneland's grounds is granted on the condition that, if required, consent is hereby given, and the Participant coming within the view of the television picture or other media display hereby agrees to sign and deliver to Keeneland upon demand releases permitting such display and the exhibition thereof.

#### RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

Participant recognizes that hazards and risks inherent in stabling, racing, training, and related activities may cause the injury or death of horses, other property, or people and does voluntarily and fully assume all risk of loss, injury, damage, death, or destruction to any person or property (including horses as well as loss of use of property). Participant further avers that Participant has fully inspected and is familiar with all Keeneland facilities (including without limitation TTC) (collectively "Keeneland Facilities"). In consideration of participating in stabling, racing, training and related activities at the Keeneland Facilities, and in consideration of the foregoing, Participant hereby voluntarily and fully assumes the risks of, and releases, holds harmless and covenants not to sue Keeneland and its affiliates, and the trustees, owners, Stewards, directors, officers, employees, and agents of any of the aforementioned persons and entities (collectively, "Indemnified Parties") for all claims for loss or damage of, or injury to, or death of any persons or property (including horses) or loss of use of property (including any loss arising from use of grass fields or gallops) sustained by the Participant and/or its invitees and/or the property owned or under the control of the Participant located at the Keeneland Facilities. This release and assumption

of risk provision shall not be effective as to any cause of loss attributable to any intentional, willful, grossly negligent, or reckless conduct of Keeneland. Participant further agrees to protect, indemnify and hold harmless Keeneland (or if indemnification is not available, to contribute to Keeneland's losses) from and against any loss, damage, claims or expenses (including reasonable attorneys' and other fees), arising directly or indirectly from any acts or omissions of the Participant, or any of the Participant's horses, or any agent, employee or invitee of the Participant, arising out of or in connection with the Participant's activities at the Keeneland Facilities. This release and indemnification shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The maintenance by Keeneland of insurance shall not affect the terms or interpretation of this Agreement. If any portion of this release and indemnification shall for any reason be held invalid or unenforceable by judicial decision or legislative amendment, the valid and enforceable provisions of this release and indemnification will continue to be given effect and shall be construed so as to provide the broadest release and indemnification permitted by law.

These conditions shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, without regard to its conflict of law rules. Any failure by Keeneland to enforce any terms or conditions of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver by Keeneland and shall not affect or impair these conditions in any way, or the right of Keeneland at any time to enforce these conditions. A Keeneland representative's approval or consent to any action proposed by Trainer or attending veterinarian shall not (a) waive Trainer or attending veterinarian's obligation to strictly comply with these Conditions, or (b) be construed as an undertaking of Keeneland, Keeneland's Vice President of Equine Safety, or any other designee of either such party to treat, diagnose, or otherwise be responsible for the condition of any horse.

#### Insurance

Prior to admission to any of the Keeneland Facilities, all trainers shall furnish Keeneland and the KHRGC with proof of insurance for general liability AND worker's compensation insurance, in such amounts and in such manner as shall be directed by Keeneland and KHRGC or as otherwise required under the stall agreement or Kentucky law. Responsibility for the maintenance of general liability, worker's compensation, and horse mortality insurance to cover the risks outlined above vests with the trainer. Consultation with a competent insurance advisor is strongly recommended. Failure to maintain adequate insurance may subject trainer to the risks outlined above.

## **EQUINE INJURY DATABASE**

Keeneland has entered into an Equine Injury Database Agreement with The Jockey Club ("TJC") to track equine injuries occurring at Keeneland. Trainer, on behalf of himself and as agent for each owner listed in the Stall Application submitted by trainer, agrees that accurate tracking of equine injuries is an important step toward improving the safety of horse racing and by accepting the use of certain stalls at Keeneland, and gives its consent to the collection of information related to any injury occurring at Keeneland to a horse owned or trained by Trainer and entry of said information into a database maintained by TJC and its affiliated businesses, including InCompass Solutions, Inc. (the "Equine Injury Database"), Keeneland, and/or the KHRGC or the Authority with respect to any injury occurring at Keeneland to a horse owned or trained by trainer. Trainer, on behalf of himself and as agent for each owner listed in the Stall Application submitted by trainer, further agrees to cooperate in the disclosure of such information to the extent that such cooperation is reasonably required and covenants not to sue and, to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, to indemnify, release and hold harmless the Indemnified Parties from and against any liability, cost, loss, or expense of any kind of nature (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees) arising from any claim, demand, or action (a) alleging that the data entered into the Equine Injury Database (either directly or indirectly) violates the rights of Participant or any third party, or (b) relating to any equine injury report run, published, or otherwise created by any of the Indemnified Parties (whether directly or indirectly).

#### **SURVEILLANCE**

By entering any horse(s), owner, trainer, their respective agents, employees and affiliates ("Entrant") acknowledge and agree that Keeneland has the right to inspect and maintain surveillance on all horses located at Keeneland, including, without limitation, horse's stall, barn and all grounds in general proximity to the physical location of the horse as Keeneland selects and deems appropriate in its sole discretion.

#### INVESTIGATIVE REPORTS FOR EMPLOYMENT

In making an application for employment or to otherwise participate in Thoroughbred racing, it is understood that an investigative report may be obtained through personal interviews with third parties, such as family members, business associates, financial sources, friends, neighbors, or others with whom you are acquainted. This inquiry includes information as to your character, general reputation, personal characteristics, and mode of living, which may be applicable. You have the right to make a written request within a reasonable period of time for a complete and accurate disclosure of additional information concerning the nature and scope of the investigation.



All races finish at the second wire except for the 1 mile and 1 1/16 mile.




