Special Notice

All horses must have a negative Coggins test dated less than one year prior to date of arrival. This certificate must accompany the health certificate on arrival to Keeneland.

The rules of racing adopted by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, in effect at the time the race is run, govern all races run under the auspices of the Keeneland Association, Inc.

Every person entering a horse in a race to be run under these rules agrees to accept the decision of the Stewards on any question relating to a race or racing.

In making this application for employment or to otherwise participate in Thoroughbred racing, it is understood that an investigative report may be made whereby information is obtained through personal interviews with third parties, such as family members, business associates, financial sources, friends, neighbors, or others with whom you are acquainted. This inquiry includes information as to your character, general reputation, personal characteristics, and mode of living,

which may be applicable. You have the right to make a written request within a reasonable period of time for a complete and accurate disclosure of additional information concerning the nature and scope of the investigation.

Keeneland may televise or authorize or license the televising of certain horse racing to be conducted in its racing plant from time to time. Accordingly, it hereby reserves television rights, whether in connection with any race, preparations thereof, ceremonies or proceedings thereafter, or training at the track. This application is accepted on the condition that, if required, consent is hereby given, and the owner, jockey, trainer, groom and all other employees of the owner coming within the view of the television picture hereby agree to sign and deliver to Keeneland upon demand releases permitting such television and the exhibition thereof.
